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CARTE BLANCHE MEAL PLANS: First year students may choose from one of four Carte Blanche meal plan options. The Carte Blanche meal plan allows the freedom to eat as many meals as desired anytime of the day in Bruff Commons Dining Room. The plus 400, 250, & 100 Greenbuck\$ allow the student to spend these tax-free dollars at any other retail dining location on campus except PJ's coffee shops. **Greenbuck\$ will roll over from the fall to spring semester ONLY if the student is enrolled in a meal plan for the spring semester.**

WAVEBUCK\$ MEAL PLANS: This plan is designed for returning students only. It gives the student 45, 55, 75, 95, or 115 meals in Bruff Commons and \$900, \$800, \$700, \$600, or \$500 in Wavebuck\$. Wavebuck\$ are tax-free dollars that may be used in all retail dining locations with the exception of PJ's coffee shops. Wavebuck\$ may also be used to access the Bruff Commons Dining Room for \$2 off of the door price. Students may purchase additional Wavebuck\$ in \$100 increments. **Wavebuck\$ will roll over from the fall to spring semester ONLY if the student is enrolled in a meal plan for the spring semester. Bruff Commons meals do not roll over.**

PELICAN PLAN: This flexible retail dollar plan gives the student \$600 in Pelicanbuck\$ to spend at any Tulane Dining location on campus except PJ's coffee shops. Students receive a sales tax exemption and \$2 off the Bruff Commons Dining Room door price. Students may purchase additional Pelicanbuck\$ in \$100 increments throughout the fall and spring semesters. This meal plan will roll over to the spring semester without the student purchasing a new meal plan for spring. If the student purchases the Pelican Plan for the spring semester only, the cost is \$675.

KOSHER PLAN: For students enrolled in a university meal plan, this option can be added for an additional \$160/semester. This includes Friday night Shabbat dinners, Wednesday night cultural meals and Passover Seder meal. This meal plan cannot be cancelled after September 18, 2009, in the fall semester and February 5, 2010, in the spring semester. Cancellations before these dates will be refunded on a pro-rata basis.

ALL FIRST YEAR STUDENTS AND SECOND YEAR STUDENTS MUST ENROLL IN A MEAL PLAN.

TERMS: All first-year students who live in University residence halls are required to enroll in one of the Carte Blanche meal plans. All second-year students who live on campus are required to carry either a Carte Blanche or Wavebuck\$ meal plan. **No exceptions are granted to the mandatory student board requirement!**

ALL FIRST YEAR STUDENTS AND SECOND YEAR STUDENTS WHO LIVE OFF CAMPUS ARE REQUIRED TO CARRY A MINIMUM MEAL PLAN OF AT LEAST THE PELICAN PLAN.

The meal plan charge appears on the student's Accounts Receivable statement. Payments may be made at the Bursar's Office or mailed to 31 McAlister Drive, Bruff Commons, Suite 102, New Orleans, LA 70118. Information on finance charges may be obtained from Accounts Receivable (504-865-5368 or 1-800-798-7633). Please do not mail payments to Dining and Vending Services.

Any attempt to fraudulently use the meal plan of another student will result in disciplinary action against both parties. Lost cards are replaced at the Tulane Card Office for a fee. **FOOD AND EQUIPMENT (including dishes & flatware) may not be removed from the Bruff Commons Dining Room. Bruff Commons Dining Room is a "DINE IN" only facility.** Violations of this rule are brought before the University Disciplinary Board. Disruptive behavior, destruction of property or violation of any University policy or code of conduct will result in sanctions through the University Disciplinary Process. Such sanctions may include but are not limited to, barring a student from participating in the board plan without a refund.

DATES:

FALL SEMESTER: The fall 2009 semester meal plan begins with breakfast on Saturday, August 22, 2009 and ends with the dinner meal on Tuesday, December 15, 2009. Labor Day, September 7, 2009, Bruff operates on weekend hours. Bruff will be closed for Thanksgiving on Wednesday, November 25, through Sunday, November 29, 2009. Students may use their Greenbuck\$/Wavebuck\$/Pelicanbuck\$ at any Tulane Dining Services facility that is open during this time.

SPRING SEMESTER: The spring 2010 semester meal plan begins with breakfast on Sunday, January 10, 2010 and ends with the dinner meal on Friday, May 7, 2010. Bruff will be closed for Mardi Gras Break, Tuesday, February 16, 2010, and for Spring Break, March 29, through Saturday, April 4, 2010. Students may use their Greenbuck\$/Wavebuck\$/Pelicanbuck\$ at any Tulane Dining Services facility that is open during this time.

CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS: Changes and cancellations must be made by 5:00pm on the following dates:

**FALL SEMESTER: SEPTEMBER 18, 2009
SPRING SEMESTER: FEBRUARY 5, 2010**

Requests for changes or cancellations must be made in person at Dining and Vending Services office.

There are no refunds of board fees except when a student withdraws timely from classes. In such a situation, a student may receive a 100 percent refund for board if withdrawal occurs prior to the first day of classes. Otherwise, refunds will be made as follows:

Refunds are made in the form of a credit to the student's Accounts Receivable account.

There is no refund of Board fees for students who withdraw from the university as a result of suspension or dismissal.

Tulane reserves the right in the case of natural disaster, pandemic flu or other catastrophic events where Tulane must cease operation for a single semester or significant portion of a semester to modify its no-refund policy. The modified no-refund policy would be determined solely at the discretion of the university administration.

Cancellations will include a \$50 administrative fee.
